

REPORT OF THE GLOBALEX MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETINGS FIRST QUARTER OF 2022

The Globalex Management Committee (MC) met virtually on January 4, February 1, and March 1, 2022. This report summarizes the major items discussed and the actions taken, combining the contents by topic.

Association news

- Australex has moved its website to a new location with updated layout, planning to have content updated soon.
- Elexis, the EU project, will end in July 2022. Everything produced within the project will be made available via CLARIN. Establishing a post-Elexis self-funding society is too expensive (and redundant). A “light-weight” option will be presented at the final (hybrid) meeting in Florence, June 7-8 (<https://elex.is/elexis-showcase-event-save-the-date>).

Conferences, events, workshops

- [Asialex 2022](#) is scheduled for June 17-19, at Guangxi University for Nationalities, Nanning, China (hybrid).
- [Afrilex 2022](#) is scheduled for June 27-29, in Stellenbosch, South Africa. It might be held hybrid or online, depending on Covid circumstances. The submission deadline was extended to the end of March.
- [Euralex 2022](#) is scheduled for July 12-16, in Mannheim, Germany. In view of the current war in Ukraine, a discussion is underway whether to sanction against participation from Russia.
- AmericaLex plans an opening conference in November 2022.
- DSNAL will meet May 31 – June 3, 2023 in Boulder, Colorado.
