

REPORT OF THE GLOBALEX MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE MEETINGS SECOND QUARTER OF 2022

The Globalex Management Committee (MC) met virtually on April 5, May 3, and June 13, 2022. This report summarizes the major items discussed and the actions taken, combining the contents by topic.

Association news

- Asialex launched the *LexTeach* project, with the aim of promoting public knowledge of lexicography and supporting dictionary use in English language learning and teaching. The first round on June 18-19, including two lectures and one workshop, was held online and requires pre-registration, limited to 100 participants per lecture/workshop.
- Elexis held a hybrid showcase event and final meeting in Florence on June 7-9 (video recordings available [here](#) and [here](#)). The project will end in July 2022, but everything produced during its lifetime will be made available via [CLARIN.SI](#) infrastructure, which will also continue to host the Globalex website and repository. The decision about continuing activity with a new Elexis association is due in the second half of 2022.
- The Americalex SCCM preparation committee continues to plan the establishment of the new association. The founding conference is scheduled in São Paulo on (tentatively) October 21-25, 2023.

Events and publications

- The [16th Nordic](#) conference on lexicography took place in Lund, Sweden, on April 27-29.
- [Asialex 2022](#) is held on June 17-19 in online mode.
- [Afrilex 2022](#) is held on June 27-29 in Stellenbosch, South Africa, in hybrid mode.
- [Euralex 2022](#) will be held on July 12-16 in Mannheim, Germany, including one day in hybrid mode open for free online participation.
- DSNA 2023 will be held on May 31 – June 3 in Boulder, Colorado (<https://dictionary.society.com/conference>).
- Australex 2023 will be held in the Alice Springs Language Centre on August 23, in conjunction with the biennial [Puliima](#) Indigenous Language and Technology Conference.
- [GWLL @ LREC 2022](#), the second Globalex Workshop on Linked Lexicography, and the fourth Globalex full-day workshop to be held in conjunction with LREC, is held on June 20, in Marseille, France, in hybrid mode. The proceedings are published as part of [LREC 2022 Workshops Proceedings](#).
- [GWLN-4 @ Euralex 2022](#), the fourth Globalex Workshop on Lexical Neologisms is held in conjunction with the Euralex 2022 conference on July 15. The proceedings are published as part of *Euralex 2022 Proceedings*.
- The proceedings of [GWLN-3](#), which was held online in conjunction with Australex 2021, were accepted for publication in *Lexicographica: Series Maior*. A request for funding for Open Access is pending. The volume will be published at the end of 2022 or early 2023.

Globalex News

- Three MC members complete their term in June and will be replaced in July:
 - Ilan Kernerman is replaced by Kilim Nam, Asialex Vice-President;

- Lars Trap-Jensen is replaced by Gilles-Maurice de Schryver, Euralex Past President;
 - Dion Nkomo is replaced by new Afrilex representative (name to be confirmed).
- In accordance with the eligibility criteria set out in the Globalex Regulations, the MC proposed to appoint the following new Chair and Vice-Chair for the term July 2022 – June 2022:
 - Amanda Laugesen, Chair; and
 - Orin Hargraves, Vice-Chair.
- The new MC will look into further organization of archives with information regarding past Globalex workshops.

Globalex Website

- The sub-committee (Lars, Amanda, Ilan) has completed basic update to the website, with the support of Teja Goli from Elexis.
- The new MC is expected to continue revamping the website.
